MODULO 5

The puritan age: historical background

Charles I; the quarrel between king and Parliament; The Civil War; Oliver Cromwell's republic.

The Restoration and the Augustan Age: historical background

The restoration of the king; James II, the Glorious Revolution and political change; the political parties; the Augustan Age: George I, Walpole and the Jacobites; England under George II; the Slave trade; the social situation.

Listening of texts about this historical period, focus on vocabulary and pronunciation.

MODULO 6

The Restoration and the Augustan Age: the literary context

The Royal Society; the Augustan Age or the 'Age of Reason', the reading public, London and Coffee houses; journalism.

The rise of the novel; general features of the novel; the great novelists of the century.

MODULO 7

Daniel Defoe

'Robinson Crusoe': the plot, the legendary figure of Robinson Crusoe; an expression of European colonial aspirations; a manifesto of economic individualism; the success of 'Robinson Crusoe'.

Reading and analysis of the passage on the textbook and on photocopies ('I was born of a good family')

Jonathan Swift

'Gulliver's Travels': the plot, Gulliver, the European, the satire.
Reading, listening and analysis of the passage on the textbook.

Robinson and Gulliver: a comparison. Analysis of differences and similarities.
